Tower Waste Line Plumbing Project: The construction defect waste line project was completed in September.

Thanks to all of our residents who were patient during this long, but much-needed project. And a BIG thanks to our contractors who worked long hours, and tirelessly, to make sure that these important repairs were successfully finalized.

Angle Stops & Shower Cartridges:

Once again, a reminder that ALL original angle stops (in toilets, under sinks, etc.) and shower cartridges should have already been replaced! If there is a leak at, or near, any of these areas, we MUST be able to turn off the water. If the stops are frozen and cannot be turned off, homeowners are responsible.

Please read the Rules & Regulations regarding "Maintenance Obligations of Homeowners". These chapters can be found beginning on page 19 of the "La Vita HOA Membership Handbook".

Flyers and Solicitations: We've had a spate of unauthorized flyers and solicitations posted on doors in both the tower and midrise.

Please be aware that many of these companies are "sketchy" at best (i.e. unlicensed carpet cleaning companies).

Also, please do not let individuals delivering flyers, etc., into the building. If you happen to notice anyone posting flyers on doors contact the onsite management office ASAP. We will escort them off of the property. If you run into them on weekends, please call security.

We are thrilled to have Roma Market open as of October 2nd! What a wonderful addition to our end of the Little Italy community.

La Vita HOA Meetings: Regular open sessions on Oct. 24 & Nov. 20 (Note date change for November). There is no meeting in December. Meetings are at 6:30pm in the meeting room on the lobby level.

Garage Etiquette: We have a lot of vehicles that move through our parking garage each day. In order to keep traffic moving smoothly remember these helpful hints:

- Cars exiting should stop on the ramp to allow for cars entering (this is due to the ramp pitch which prohibits cars entering from being able to have a visual down the ramp)
- Cars entering should STOP at the bottom of the ramp (note the stop sign above) and check the mirrors. Please wait for oncoming vehicles that need to enter the ramp area

Please watch speeds in the parking garage and utilize the mirrors at the turns.

Hepatitis A in downtown San Diego: Due to the hepatitis A outbreak in San Diego, our custodial crew has been trained in procedures in blood-born pathogens and Hep A safety.

Water Water Everywhere!

Once again we ask all residents to exercise caution when cleaning balconies and decks, and/or watering plants on balconies.

If you (or any household help) clean the balconies with water avoid allowing the water to drip (or cascade!) from the balcony onto lower units. What may seem like a miniscule amount of water can damage outdoor plants and furniture, and shower unsuspecting residents below.

Budget and HOA dues: At the 9/26/17 Open Session meeting the 2017-2018 budget was approved. The full budget and budget details will be mailed to all homeowners in November.

The approved HOA dues increase was set at 3% to cover an increase in operational costs.

The new HOA dues amount will begin in January. Please plan accordingly.
