CC&R and Bylaw Amendments: On February 13, the ballots for CC&R and Bylaw Amendments were tallied. The results were as follows:

CC&R amendment to remove developer language - 172 Yes; 41 No

Bylaw amendment to remove developer language - 173 Yes; 38 No (passed with simple majority) Change short-term rental from 30 days to 90 days - 126 Yes; 99 No Sub-metering - 67 Yes; 155 No Majority approval for the CC&R amendment instead of 67% - 109 Yes; 115 No

The Board will provide info on next steps soon.

Pet Reminder! Please remember that according to the Rules and Regulations of La Vita, your pets cannot be left unattended on balconies or patios. We have noticed an uptick in noise complaints from unattended dogs.

If you are not at home make sure your pups are secure inside. Also close doors and windows. It is surprising how noise carries throughout the "canyon" of downtown highrises!

Pool and Spa News: Beginning in March (dates TBA) the pool and spa will be closed for approximately 3 weeks. The closure is so that a new pool company can remove the plaster (which was utilized in error by a previous contractor) and apply fiberglass. This will allow for a longer life for the pool and spa interiors. We will update residents with dates as soon as possible.

Frequently Asked Questions

What are some of the most important 2020 Reminders?

Plumbing Reminders: Are your angle stops replaced and up-to-date? The inability to turn off your angle stops to your sinks or toilet can be a major issue.

How about all of your supply lines? Have they been updated with braided stainless lines? Leaking supply lines are a major source of flooding.

This frequently impacts your neighbors. So be a good neighbor and make sure to take care of this major maintenance issue!

Dryer Vents and Ducts: Remember to clean your topside dryer filters at least once per month. The filters are located in the ceiling above the dryer.

- Slide the plexi door out of the guides and clean the wire mesh.
- If your filter is damaged or needs replacing you can order them at: Reversomatic.com or call (941)-870-2320. Door screen is model number 021175 associated with LT-180F.
- Is your dryer taking a long time to dry your clothes? If you have already cleaned your filter and your clothes are still taking a long time to dry you may need to have your ducts professionally cleaned.
- Check for dampness or drips inside the washer area and/or your balcony vent.
- Look at the grill on your balcony vent. If there is obvious dryer lint you may need to have the ducts cleaned.
- Also check to make sure the fan is running. Signs of a nonworking fan are damp areas in the washer/dryer closet

Door Locks: Did you know that changing your locks on the hallway doors needs to go through the Architectural Committee for approval? Locks (whether traditional, keypad, or "Ring"-type video locks) need to be a brushed silver/nickel in color. Contact the management office for more details.

Lock Boxes: All lockboxes MUST be stored in the cabinet by the Union St. gate AND registered with the office. No boxes are allowed on gates. Unregistered lock boxes will be removed.

HOA Dues for 2020: An important reminder that your HOA dues increased in January 2020. Make sure that your payments reflect the new amount! If you have auto-pay with APS the change will occur automatically. If you use a bank bill-pay or other form of payment you will need to make the change yourself. The difference between the new and old amounts will accrue and may result in late fees.

Carpet and Lobby: We will update residents on the Tower lobby project as we firm up dates for closures. Thank you for your patience.
